Who Can Come?

All children ages 4 - 12 years are encouraged to attend.

(a child must be 4 years-old by July 1st to participate)

Due to the continuing COVID-19 pandemic numbers will be limited, so register early!



All necessary precautions along with state and CDC guidelines will be taken as needed to insure the children's safety.

What Will Happen?

Each day the day campers are with their same small group and counselors. Playing games, making arts & crafts, singing, having fun, and making friends happen all on the way to learning that, "God wants us to help other people!"

But that's not all . . . there's also Special Events for day campers and/or their families: an Ice Cream Social, special guests, Wild & Wet Day and an Open House!

What about Lunch & Snacks?

To assure that individual dietary needs are met, everyone needs to bring their own lunch, and a beverage, each day. Don't worry, if your child forgets their lunch one day, additional limited food is available.

We also ask that your child brings their own water bottle to use during the week. The water bottles can be stored for the week for your child's own private use or carried back and forth each day.

There will also be a light snack and drink (or water) each day, provided by the Day Camp staff.

☼ **Special Daily Activities**

Each afternoon we will have special activities led by people in our community. These special guests will share with our campers how God wants us to help others.

☼ **Wet & Wild Day (Friday, weather permitting)**

One day we'll all have a "blast" with water - games, competitions, water slides and more. Since we need to watch the weather, we'll tell you which day will be "Wet & Wild Day" on the first day of camp. Bring your bath towel, swimsuit, and water shoes or sandals on that day!

☼ **Ice Cream Social, 7 PM, Thursday, July 28th**

Day campers, and especially parents and friends are invited to come and experience what their child has done and learned during the week. In addition, meet the Day Camp volunteers & staff, pick-up the crafts made and enjoy a summer evening ice cream social, for FREE!

There is NO Day Camp Fee!

We are once again providing our summer day camp without a fee and are just asking for monetary donations to help cover our costs.
