SOCIAL AND MISSIONAL OUTREACH: I am so excited to announce that the North Warren Presbyterian Church playground is up and running!!

This was an outreach that I felt near and dear to my heart. About a year and a half ago, I felt drawn to the playground, and to help eliminate some of the bad behavior going on within the neighborhood and hopefully provide a safe and fun environment for families to frequent again!!

What is Christian missional outreach? The meaning of a Christian missional outreach is the act of Christians actively sharing their faith and demonstrating God's love through actions and words, extending beyond the church walls to engage with the wider community. It encompasses both evangelism, sharing the Gospel, and acts of service, often meeting both spiritual and physical needs.

In essence, Christian missional outreach is about living out the Christian faith in a way that impacts the lives of others.

I personally wanted to extend my faith, serve the community, and build new relationships! In my eyes, a playground serves as a way for churches to reach out to the wider community and demonstrate our commitment to families.

We all have a calling to God. And he speaks to us in different ways. Some with prayer..some with missional outreach..some with missionary work! Everyone's calling is different! None wrong, we are all an important part!




Prayer Chain
