Jonah (from cover) catches one's eye when entering the Sistine Chapel, his head thrown back so that we naturally follow his line of sight, we look to see, which sets our eyes moving along the central panels with the stories of the Creation and of the life of Noah. When we reach the end of the ceiling, the prophets along the sides lead our eyes back round to Jonah, and the promise of the Resurrection, symbolized by the days and nights he spent in the belly of the fish, which foretell the days, and nights Christ would spend in his tomb.
