

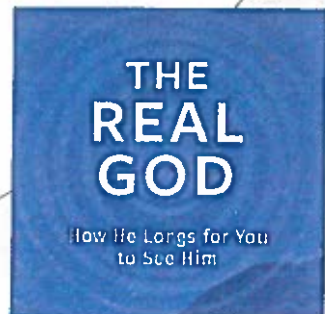
God's Faithfulness
