TITLE: "*Children of the Resurrection*"                      TEXTS: Luke 20:27-38

I. Introduction: In today's text the Sadducees confront Jesus with a ridiculous, hypothetical question about a woman whose husband dies .

II. What is Jesus saying to the Sadducees and to us in today's text?.
