Sermon Outline for Sunday Morning, February 16, 2020 Rev. Ward

TITLE: "Jesus and Sin"

TEXTS: Matthew 5:21-37

SERIES: "Looking at Jesus with 2020 vision" (Part 7)

- I. Introduction: We can't understand certain Bible passages unless we understand their context , that is the first part of the conversation.

- II. Jesus says that sin goes far deeper than overt action , it involves the inner attitude that leads up to that action .

- III. Jesus is saying that sin doesn't start where we think it does .

- IV. Jesus is also saying sin doesn't end where you think it does either.

- V. The final point Jesus is making here is that the starting and ending point of righteousness is living with the heart and mind of God within our souls .
