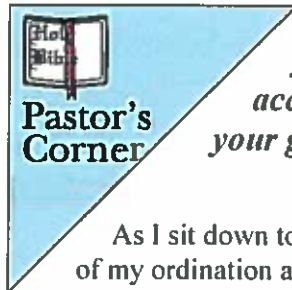

Budget Concerns at NWPC

NWPC is experiencing a dramatic shortfall in our 2022 financial giving. Our envelope giving is down about \$9,000.00 compared to 2021.



We have had to draw down on our Unrestricted Cash investment account annual distribution which we have never had to do since we established Investment Accounts. Expenses have come in higher than last year. Our bottom line is 2022 -\$8,204 and 2021 +\$3,440. We are asking that if you are behind on your giving, can you please catch up? If you are able, can you please increase your giving so we can get out of the red and back into the black?

We have had to draw down in August the rest of our 2022 distributions from investments. Anything you can do to help will be greatly appreciated. Let's all pray about this and see how we can all join together and allow us to be able to meet our planned programs for 2022.

The Sharing Place is still here and serving hot meals every Thursday. As you know, we have been serving only take-out since March 12, 2020, when COVID-19 forced us to “temporarily” stop serving sit-down dinners. **Since March 12, 2020, Sharing Place has served 7,162 takeout meals!**

That “temporarily” has lasted longer than we could have been imagined. Not a single Thursday was missed (other than holidays) in that period of time! But, we have missed that shared time of fellowship and community and have missed working with the volunteers from the many congregations.

So, we are going to take a small step toward where we were in the “before days” and ask each of the participating churches to provide desserts on a rotating basis. Cookies work best as they are easy to portion, easy to freeze, and easy to store. Assuming all of the churches choose to resume doing this, NWPC would only be responsible every 7th week.

Once we know what weeks our church is assigned, we will be asking for volunteers to provide cookies.
