# Sermon Outline for July 16, 2023 Ruling Elder Gloria Lindell TITLE: "The Extravagant Sower!" TEXT: Matthew 13:1-9, 18-23 I. Introduction: It may be more meaningful to rename parables from the perspective of the giver rather than the recipient. Then we can focus on the grace in each parable rather than the works. So, let's consider today's parable as that of . . . II. Many ancient sources speak of plowing before sowing, but others clearly speak of sowing first. Jesus chooses the later method for this parable, since only \_\_\_\_\_ knows the \_\_\_\_ kinds of \_\_\_\_ among whom the \_\_\_\_ is \_\_\_ . III. So, when we share the gospel with others, we should not limit our sowing to those we assume are the "good soil" but scatter our seed everywhere and be like our Lord
